### What you will need

Sewing machine and the knowledge to use it (you will need zig zag)  
Solid cotton fabric (normally taffeta or satin is used, but for this class you will work with cotton): 1.5 yd of your background color; 1 yard each of your design color(s).

A spool of thread to match each of your design colors  
A good pair of fabric scissors.

Due to the usage of sewing machines, ironing boards/irons and the importance of individual attention, the class size will be limited.

A light lunch will be provided.
